

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TRAINING IN SCOTLAND AND NORTHERN IRELAND

Electrotechnical NVQ and SVQ training information

There are two types of qualifications available to OLCI Construction Training students living or training in Scotland and Northern Ireland – NVQ (National Vocational Qualification) and SVQ (Scottish Vocational Qualification).

OLCI is an accredited training provider for the Level 3 NVQ Diploma (2357) in Installing Electrotechnical Systems and Equipment. This is the recognised qualification in England and Wales that will enable you to be a qualified Electrician.

We are also an approved SQA Centre and we are in the process of achieving subject approval for the SVQ Level 3 Electrotechnical Services qualification. The SVQ is a qualification specific to Scotland and Northern Ireland, although it is fully recognised in England and Wales too.



The enrolment process

You can enrol on a Level 3 NVQ Diploma (2357)

You can enrol on this course regardless of whether you are employed or unemployed.

To enrol, simply contact an OLCI Career Advisor on Freephone 0800 058 2848.

Alternatively you can enrol on a SVQ Level 3 Electrotechnical Services

You must be employed in an electrical-related job before we can register you on this course.

If you wish to register you will need to contact SECTT, the trade association for the electrical industry in Scotland. You will be asked to take an industry pre-enrolment assessment. SECTT will guide you through the SVQ registration process. You should then contact SECTT to let them know that you would like to study with OLCI. If you would like to run your own business, you can enrol on our NVQ course.

If you would prefer to be employed by a company then you could also enrol on our NVQ course, as a number of our learners who have successfully completed our NVQ courses are working in Scotland. It should be mentioned that some employers, particularly those who are members of SECTT, may require you have an SVQ and hold the SNIJIB card. You could ask potential employers which qualification they would require you to have, if you were to apply for a job with them.
